**ADESTA'S SAFETY DIRECTOR HONORED WITH GOLD AWARD**

***Third year in a row Denny Teymer honored***

**OMAHA, Neb.**, (June 3, 2005) – Adesta, a multi-discipline infrastructure service provider and integrator, today announced that Denny Teymer, safety director for Adesta LLC, was selected by the Greater Omaha Chapter of the National Safety Council to receive their prestigious Gold Award of Honor. The award recognizes Teymer for outstanding occupational safety and health program results and achievement during 2004. The presentation took place on May 19, 2005 during the Annual Awards Luncheon at the Safety and Health Summit and Tradeshow at the Qwest Center Omaha. This is the third year in a row that Teymer was recognized for his efforts. He received the National Safety Council's Silver Award of Honor in 2004 and Bronze Award of Honor in 2003.

The Occupational Safety and Health Awards Recognition Program was established by the National Safety Council's Greater Omaha Chapter in 1984 to encourage and recognize excellence in accident prevention and loss control programs. To be considered for an award, a company must have an incident rate and lost work day case rate the same or better than the latest available industry average for their Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) as recorded by the United States Bureau of Labor Statistics Estimates of Occupational Injury and Illness Incidence Rates. All companies considered for award recognition must have a written injury/illness prevention plan or equivalent.

Teymer oversees all safety programs for Adesta's regional offices, project sites, and corporate office in Omaha. As safety director, he supervises the administration of company policies and procedures by all safety managers and safety engineers. In

addition, Teymer oversees a company-wide incentive program that rewards employees for successfully upholding the program and avoiding the hazards presented in our various lines of work. The company builds and installs transportation, telecommunications, and security systems and requires procedures for construction, electrical work, aerial work, and building and maintaining underground facilities.

Teymer became the safety director after serving three years as safety manager for Adesta. During this time, he developed safety programs for many job-specific situations: confined space, lockout tagout, hazard communication, forklift, trenching, and excavations. Before joining the company in 1992, Teymer was employed as a safety engineer at Kiewit Network Technologies, Inc., where he monitored the safety standards of employees and subcontractors.

Teymer served for three years in the United States Army and 19 years in the Iowa National Guard and Naval Reserve. He began his career in safety as an instructor, chairing the Driver and Safety Department for Maquoketa Community Schools. He then moved to the Iowa Safety Council, Inc., working as a trainer/consultant.
